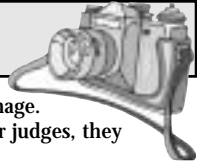
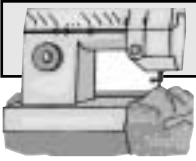

RELEASE TIME:

All articles to be left in place until Sunday, August 5, 2007, at which time they will be released from 12 noon to 3:00 p.m. No articles are to be removed before this release time, unless in certain baked good categories. The Greene County Agricultural Society WILL NOT be responsible for any articles remaining after Sunday, August 5, 2007 after 3:00pm.

RULES

1. Ages 9 and under:

There will be a \$10.00 entry fee. This fee does not include a ticket to enter the fair because children 9 and under enter the fair free with paying adult.

Ages 10-17:

There are four options:

A. Pay \$10.00 entry fee with no exhibitor's ticket to enter the fair.

B. 4-H/FFA who wish to enter may do so for \$10.00.

C. Pay \$15.00 and exhibit up to 10 items and receive a mini exhibitor ticket which allows entrance to the fair for three days.

D. Pay \$25.00 and exhibit as many items in any department and receive an exhibitor ticket which will allow you to enter the fair every day for 7 days.

2. This Department is open to residents of Greene and surrounding counties.

3. All articles in this department MUST be in the MERCANTILE BUILDING on Thursday, July 26th between the hours of 9:00a.m. and 8:00p.m. except for baking (see that class).

4. Entries may be made in as many classes as desired, but only ONE entry per exhibitor in each book entry number.

5. All entry tags must be attached securely to each entry.

6. Each painting, drawing and/or photograph must be properly framed and/or matted for hanging. Please DO NOT use tape, rubber bands, paper clips or saw tooth hangers to hang exhibits. Adhesives, such as hot glue, do not last through heat and humidity of fair week. If work is matted, mat board should NOT exceed 3-inches beyond edge of print. Pictures, including frame, should be no more than 16"X20". No number painting. No nudes. Attach entry tags at upper right corner. Not responsible if picture falls due to improper hanging.

7. This department reserves the right to reject any article soiled, stained or because of size and/or content.

8. The Fair Board will do everything possible to see that articles are properly

protected, but can assume no obligation for loss or damage. At the discretion of the building superintendents and/or judges, they may dispose any item not worthy to keep.

9. This department will be divided into three (3) groups: Pre-juniors (7 yrs and under), Juniors (8 yrs -12 yrs), and Teenagers (13 yrs-17 yrs) in all classes.

10. Directions on rules must be followed in all categories or entry will be disqualified.

11. Entries in all classes are to be made and completed by exhibitor.

12. Astericks (****) will mark new item or information.
