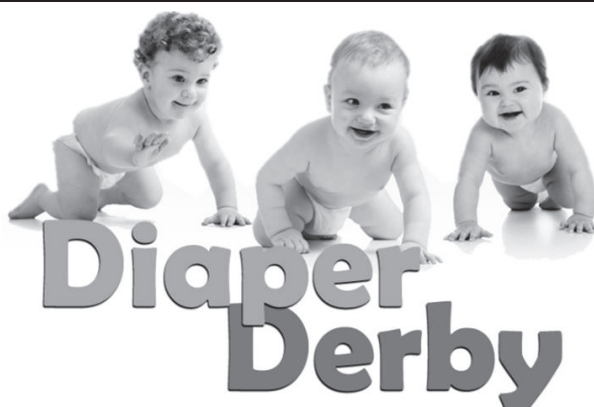


2019 Diaper Derby Contest

The Contest: The parent will place the baby at the starting line. At the starter’s signal, the parents go to the end of the finish line to call the baby. Only one parent can call the baby and must stay at the finish line at all times. Toys or other items that will attract the baby may be used but they may not enter the race or be thrown across the race area. The baby that crosses the finish line first will be declared the winner.

Entry Requirements: The baby must be crawling. Babies who are walking are not able to participate. A baby that takes one walking step during the race will be congratulated but will be disqualified.

Registration: Pre-registration entry form is **required** in the Administration Office. Entry closes at noon on Wednesday, July 31st.

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to all participants. Prizes will also be awarded to 1st and 2nd finishers in each class. An overall grand prize winner will be awarded a baby basket full of goodies. Prizes provided by Soin Medical Center.

Classes: Classes will be determined by age Depending on the number of participants. The fastest baby from each class will then race in the final for the grand prize!
