Pits open 4:00 p.m. • Registration open at 5:00 p.m.

ENTER THROUGH FRONT GATE

\$20.00 per entry (payouts based on \$25)

Pit Passes: \$5 per person (including driver)

Weight Classes: 6500lb and lower; 6525lb - 9000 lb.

1. Must have a valid driver's license to pull
2. Must have clevis or D-ring at least 4-inch inside diameter
3. Hitch height can be no taller than 30 inches from the ground
4. Must listen to officials when it is your turn to pull
5. Your assigned number to will be announced from the P.A., it is your responsibility to come to the pulling area when number is called. If you do not come to pull after called upon, you can be disqualified with no refund.
6. No riders allowed in vehicle during pull
7. The winner is the best of two out of three pulls
8. Winner of pull must re-weigh after each winning pull
9. You can only buy back into pull one time after you lose your first pull (same price as first pull) *if time permitting*
10. Vehicle can be gas or diesel as long as they make weight
11. Any mechanical failure automatically results in a disqualification from the tug-a-truck contest
12. Neither the Greene County Fair nor Tug-A-Truck officials are liable for actions of drivers. All drivers **PULL AT YOUR OWN RISK**. The Greene County Agricultural Society shall be held harmless from any and all claims of every type, character and description pertaining to or growing out of participating as well as the usage of said premises for this event. Further, persons pulling during this event covenants and agree that they will use the same in a lawful manner and will make every effort to conduct this event and activity upon said premises in such a manner as to avoid injury or damage to the public or property of Greene County Agricultural Society. By pulling your vehicle at the Greene County Fair in the year 2011, you agree to all terms and conditions. By signing this form I understand and agree to all the above rules and guidelines. 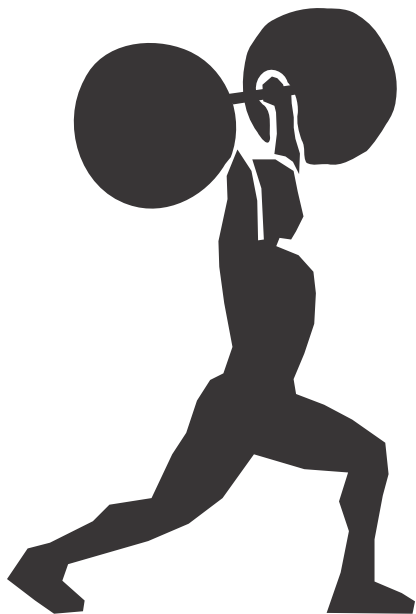
